

Tonight's Referee **DARREN ENGLAND**

DARREN ENGLAND, enjoyed a distinguished career as an assistant referee before switching to the middle of the pitch and was Fourth Official for the 2014 UEFA Super Cup Final (Real Madrid v. Sevilla). He became an EFL referee in 2015, taking charge of the 2017 League Two Play-off Final at Wembley.

He has been refereeing in the Premier League since 2019. Amongst his refereeing appointments this season have been Wolves v. Chelsea, Fulham v. Aston Villa, Manchester United v. Nottingham Forest, Everton v. Tottenham, Bournemouth v. Liverpool and West Ham v. Brentford. He has served on the FIFA List of International Match Officials since 2022.


